### Looking Forward to Next Year -

Our Annual General Meeting will be held on March 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm, ahead of the Monday night dance. All dancers, including New Dancers, have voting rights and we encourage all members to attend. We will have some bylaw changes that will need sufficient numbers at the meeting for the voting. The AGM agenda and the proposed bylaw changes will be distributed at the beginning of March.

This is also the night that the Executive and Committees for next year will be established. Nancy and Brent Daignault, as Past Presidents, have the responsibility to prepare a nomination slate for the AGM meeting. There are still a few vacancies to be filled. Below are brief explanations of the roles that are open. It takes many people to run a square dance club – strong leadership from the whole community is essential.

**Vice President** - The overall purpose and responsibility of this role is to assume the President's role in their absence and to share the President's workload.

**Secretary** - The overall purpose and responsibility of this role is to prepare accurate minutes of Executive Committee Meetings and Annual General Meetings to be stored in the Club Archives, and to file the Annual Return with the Alberta Government. This person in this role needs word processing skills.

**Advertising** - The overall purpose and responsibility of this role is to design posters and tickets for Queens & Jacks events. The person/people in this role need intermediate Word skills.

**Membership** - The overall purpose and responsibility of this role is to develop and maintain an accurate and up to date database of the members of the Queens & Jacks Square Dance Club in order to be able to produce an annual roster. The person/people in this role need intermediate Excel skills and be able to perform a mail merge in Word.

**Social Media (Facebook)** – The overall purpose and responsibility of the role is to give Queens & Jacks a presence on social media.

### Winterfest -

The Winterfest dances were great dances and well attended by Queens & Jacks members - about 1 ½ squares on the Saturday night Mainstream dance and a square at the Plus dance. There were almost 2 full squares from Red Deer and Edmonton – Gary Winter Groupies they call themselves! Gary had us doing lots of unusual things including a left-handed Spin Chain Thru! Try that!!


