There were 3 exhibition groups from Colorado and California who demonstrated various dance forms that preceded modern square dancing. There were



educational seminars on such topics as promoting square dancing to grow your club and how to increase the sociability of your club. There were things going on from 9 am to sometimes 11 pm. It was so much fun, and especially fun to share it with club members. Thank you to all who volunteered to help out before and at the festival – that was about 15 of you.
