### **District Introductory Dance -**

Calgary & District Square and Round Dancers Association (C&D) also puts on an Introductory Dance for people to try out square dancing. The dance will be held at McDougall United Church on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm. This is an excellent opportunity for people to have either their first try or to have an additional trial night! See the attached poster.

### **Prepayment Options for Mainstream Dancers -**

Did you know that Queens and Jacks has a prepayment plan? Yes, we do!! If you find it inconvenient to bring cash to each dance night, you might want to consider using the prepayment method. Simply prepay a lump sum - either by cash at a dance or by e-transfer, and then when you attend, just check in at the registration desk and your attendance will be recorded, and the appropriate amount will be deducted from your prepaid balance. You can start and stop the prepayment system whenever you like, and you can request a refund of your balance at any time.

To pay by e-transfer, using your on-line banking, send an email to <u>treasurerqueensandjacks@gmail.com</u>.

Dance fees for the 2024-25 session are as follows:

- 1. Membership: \$15 per person, can be paid by cash, cheque or e-Transfer.
- 2. Sept 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, 7-9pm: \$5 per person. Note that these are the two introductory nights where we have invited the general public to come and try square dancing, at no charge to them.
- 3. Monday dances, Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> onward, 7-10pm: \$7.50 per person. This is our new Monday night format which starts with a lesson at 7pm, followed by a mainstream dance 8:30-10pm.
- 4. Friday dances, 7:30-10pm: \$7.50 per person. Pre-rounds at 7:30pm. Squares start at 8 pm.

### **C&D Summer Dances –**

The Tuesday night Intro Hours and C&D Summer Dances went well - we had about 15 new people come to try square dancing during the Intro Hours each night, and had up to 6 squares for the Mainstream dance. There was usually at least a square of Queens & Jacks members attending.

### Harvest Moon Dance -

Our first special event will be the Harvest Moon Dance being held on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup>. This is an event where we invite members from other clubs to join us, so if you have friends in other clubs, encourage them to come. Round dancing is at 7:30pm and square dancing at 8:00pm. The dance will be followed by dessert and a social time. See attached poster.
