### **Important Club Stuff**

ALSO IMPORTANT – We have been talking a bit about how the moves in the Mainstream programme are going to change. CALLERLAB, the international body that governs square dancing, has voted to decrease the number of moves that make up the Mainstream programme and increase the number of moves in the Plus programme – which is the programme that follows Mainstream. The programme is attached below and will officially begin in September 2026.

As an Executive and Board of Directors we voted in September, with Glenn's encouragement, to try an experiment on October 27th and November 24th during the Mainstream dance time – 8:45 to 9:30 pm – to learn some Plus moves.

As for Round dancing – Glenn has committed to have a round dance on the third Monday of the month (October 20th and November 17th), and for the first ½ hour of our special events.


### **Past Club Activities**



On behalf of the Calgary Callers and Cuers Association and the request of Lorne Smith, I am contacting you with an invitation and opportunity for you to share with your experienced dancers.

Lorne Smith is hosting monthly new caller workshops on zoom. The thing that makes these workshops unique is having live dancers on the floor. As far as we know, this is the only caller education online using this approach. There are more than 20 zoom caller participants calling to the floor from Alberta, BC, Saskatchewan, the USA, Australia, and other countries too.

Having 2 squares of live dancers at his home for the zoom workshops is beneficial for the dancers. With 2 full squares dancers can rotate in and out between sections of the teaching. It is a workshop so there is standing in the square as the caller participants work out the exercises. And we definitely enjoy some quiet visiting on the sidelines.

It isn't often we as dancers have a chance to help callers hone their craft. As a new caller myself I can vouch for the value of this support from Lorne and the dancing community.
